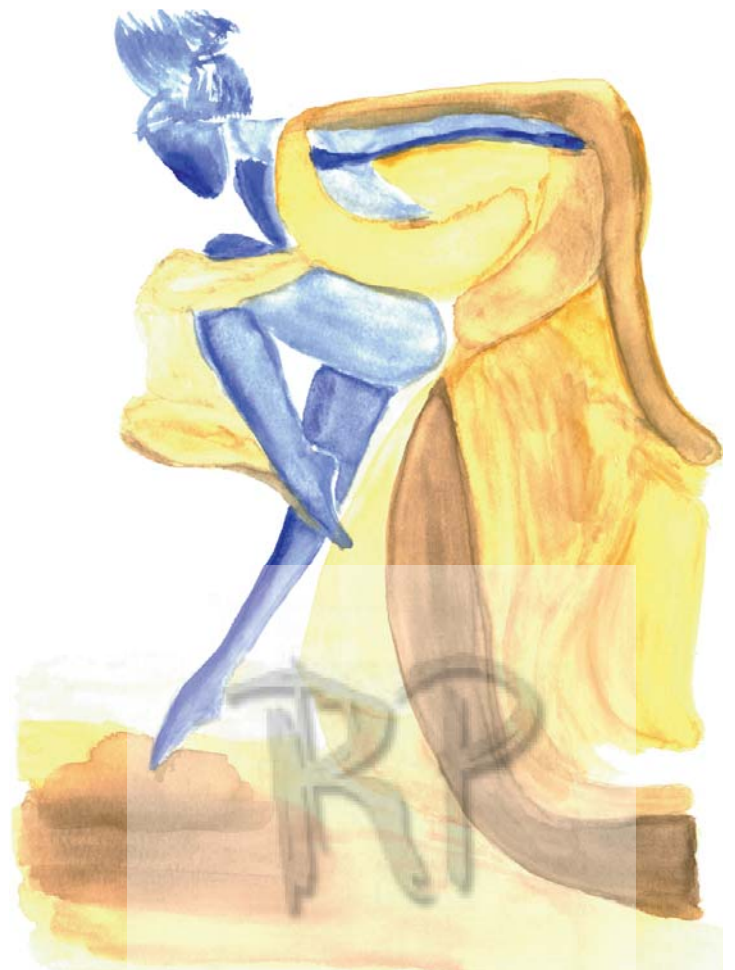
Biographical Information
